With its application to nursing assessment, patient management, critical thinking skills and the ability to apply best evidence to practice. It is a <u>self-directed program</u> comprising of online learning activities, e-learning modules, face to face study days, tutorials and submission of academic assessments.</p> <p>This is a core unit within the SCGH Postgraduate (PG) Nursing Courses and a pre-requisite requirement for SCGH PG Pathway Programs. It receives advanced standing at Edith Cowan University in PG study.</p> <p>Note: E-learning will take at least 64 hours to complete.</p>
