It includes four (4) workshops from the Teaching on the Run (TOTR) series- Clinical Supervision, Clinical Teaching, Skills Teaching, and Assessment. It is developed by The University of Western Australia, <i>TELL Centre</i> and delivered by accredited TOTR facilitators.</p> <p>This is an essential program for all nurses who precept nursing students, orientate and support new nurses to their clinical ward/areas and have teaching and assessment responsibilities.</p> <p>NOTE: This day includes the same workshops as for Teaching on the Run (TOTR) Day 1</p>
